I ORGANIZERS

This Interscholastic is organized by the Interscholastic Management and the Faculty of Humanities and Education of the Universidad Andrés Bello, sponsored by the Society of Writers of Chile, SECH.

II OBJECTIVES

- Encouraging and promoting the literary creation in Chilean teenagers, in a wide diversity.
- Developing the skill in tale writing.
- Opening leisure spaces for high school students

III PARTICIPANTS

Only high school students along Chile are allowed to participate in this contest.

Direct Relatives (Children/Siblings) of active workers from Universidad Andres Bello, Antartica Bookstore, El Mercurio, and Chilean Writer Society will not be able to participate.

IV REGISTRATION

The work reception will be open from March 03 and close on June 27th at 12:00 hours. To participate you must send a tale as an attached file when you register to the contest. The registration form is available in our web site <http://interescolares.unab.cl>

The tales must include in the first page the following information:

Complete name of the author, School, Grade, and City

A brief description about what motivates you to write. This description must be written in English. We will not accept a tales that does not come with this information.

V MODALITY

- It is an individual work.
- Maximum three tales per student.

- The length of the tale is between 2 and 4 pages.
- The stories must be configured for letter size paper, written in Arial 12, double space (2.0)
- The theme of each story is free.
- Only stories that meet these requirements, otherwise will be received, shall be considered invalid.
- The margin of the story should be "Normal", ie: top margin 2.5cm, 2.5cm Bottom, Left and Right 3cm 3cm.
- It is very important that all participants comply with these requirements.

VI EVALUATION CRITERIA

- In this first stage the 15 best stories will be selected.
- The top 3, 7, and 5 special honorable mention awards will be determined.
- At the time that the jury make the decision, take into account the following aspects:
 - Drafting consistent.
 - Themed Originality
 - Innovative narrative structure.
 - Ability to create possible worlds.
 - Creativity literary text.

VII JURY

The honorable judges of 8° Interscholastic Short Stories in English, will consist of prominent national writers, literary critics and teachers of this University.

VIII PRIZES

Be awarded to authors of the top 15 stories of 8 ° Interscholastic Stories in English:

- Editing a book that brings together the 15 best stories from each of the venues and the authors will be given 03 copies of this book.

The 15 awards of the 7° Interscholastic Stories in English in each of the venues are available at the following structure:

- **Special Prize Gabriela Mistral** will receive a voucher for \$ 30,000 to be exchanged in Antarctica Bookseller.
- **Pablo Neruda Special Award** will receive a voucher for \$ 30,000 to be exchanged in Antarctica Bookseller.
- **José Miguel Varas Special Award** will receive a voucher for \$ 30,000 to be exchanged in Antarctica Bookseller.
- **Special Prize Nicanor Parra** will receive a voucher for \$ 30,000 to be exchanged in Antarctica Bookseller.
- **Special Prize Isabel Allende** will receive a voucher for \$ 30,000 to be exchanged in Antarctica Bookseller.

- **Special Prize Antonio Skármeta** receive a voucher for \$ 30,000 to be exchanged in Antartica Bookseller.
- **Special Prize Gonzalo Rojas** will receive a voucher for \$ 30,000 to be exchanged in Antartica Bookseller.
- Honorable mentions, 5 students will receive a ticket of \$15.000 pesos to be changed in Antartica Bookstore.

The teachers whose students have obtained one of the 3 first prizes or Special prizes will receive a ticket of \$15.000 pesos to be changed in Antartica Bookstore.

We will also give a special Prize to the teachers whose students sent the larger amount of short story to the contest. The teacher will receive \$30.000 to be changed in Antartica Bookstore.

IX PUBLICATION

By participating, the student authorizes the University to edit and publish the story of the contest participant. This publication is free. The books will be delivered at the award ceremony.

X AWARDS CEREMONY

The awards ceremony will be held in Santiago, Campus Casona de Las Condes, Fernandez Concha 700, Las Condes, 13 November at 17:00 hours.

The invitation to the Awards Ceremony is only for students who obtained some recognition in this interschool.

During the ceremony not only will be awarded to the winners, we will also have a meeting with the prominent literary writer will lecture for all participants.

We remind the participating students presented with the uniform of his property the day of the awards ceremony.

XI GENERAL RULES

The works will not be given back to the students.

The organizing committee will be in charge to solve about unexpected situations in the present regulations. And also, this committee is allowed to arbitrate the measurements and use the necessary tools according to the nature and/or topic of the conflict. They will apply the adequate mechanisms to solve the problem.
