I ORGANIZERS

This Interscholastic is organized by the Interscholastic Management and the Faculty of Humanities and Education of the Universidad Andrés Bello, sponsored by the Society of Writers of Chile, SECH.

II OBJECTIVES

- Encouraging and promoting the literary creation in Chilean teenagers, in a wide diversity.
- Developing the skill in tale writing.
- Opening leisure spaces for high school students

III PARTICIPANTS

Only high school students along Chile are allowed to participate in this contest.

Direct Relatives (Children/Siblings) of active workers from Universidad Andres Bello, Antartica Bookstore, El Mercurio, and Chilean Writer Society will not be able to participate.

IV REGISTRATION

The work reception will be open from March 05 and close on June 29th at 12:00 hours. To participate you must send a tale as an attached file when you register to the contest. The registration form is available in our web site http://interescolares.unab.cl.

The tales must include in the first page the following information:

Complete name of the author, School, Grade, and City

A brief description about what motivates you to write. This description must be written in English. We will not accept a tales that does not come with this information.

V MODALITY

- It is an individual work.
- Maximum three tales per student.
- The length of the tale is between 2 and 4 pages.
- Letter size, written in ARIAL 12 to double space.
- The topic is free.
- We will only receive the tales that fulfill these requirements, if not, the works will not be accepted as valid.

VI EVALUATION CRITERIA

- In the first stage the best 15 tales will be selected.
- It will be determined 3 first places, 7 special prizes and 5 honorable mentions.
- It will be taken into account the coherent writing.
- Topic originality.
- Innovative writing structure.
- Capacity to create possible worlds.
- Literary creativity of the text.

VII JURY

The honorable judges of 6° Interscholastic Short Stories in English, will consist of prominent national writers, literary critics and teachers of this University.

VIII PRIZES

Be awarded to authors of the top 15 stories of 6 ° Interscholastic Stories in English:

- Editing a book that brings together the 15 best stories from each of the venues and the authors will be given 20 copies of this book.

The 15 awards of the 6° Interscholastic Stories in English in each of the venues are available at the following structure:

- 1st place an IPAD
- 2nd place a Cell Phone
- 3rd place an IPOD Nano of 8 Gb, or a similar one that will be available in the market at that time.
- Special prizes, 7 students will receive a ticket of \$30.000 pesos to be changed in Antartica Bookstore.
- Honorable mentions, 5 students will receive a ticket of \$15.000 pesos to be changed in Antartica Bookstore.

The teachers whose students have obtained one of the 3 first prizes or Special prizes will receive a ticket of \$15.000 pesos to be changed in Antartica Bookstore.

We will also give a special Prize to the teachers whose students sent the larger amount of short story to the contest. The teacher will receive \$30.000 to be changed in Antartica Bookstore.

IX PUBLICATION

By participating, the student authorizes the University to edit and publish the story of the contest participant. This publication is free. The books will be delivered at the award ceremony.

X AWARDS CEREMONY

The awards ceremony will be held in Santiago, Campus Casona de Las Condes, Fernandez Concha 700, Las Condes, 08 November at 17:00 hours.

To award the prize to the winners is essential that both the teacher and students, be present at the awards ceremony. The prizes will not be given if the winners are not present.

We extend the invitation to the awards ceremony for all participants of this Interscholastic. During the ceremony we will not only award the winners but a prominent literary writer will give a conference for all participants.

XI GENERAL RULES

The works will not be given back to the students.

The organizing committee will be in charge to solve about unexpected situations in the present regulations. And also, this committee is allowed to arbitrate the measurements and use the necessary tools according to the nature and/or topic of the conflict. They will apply the adequate mechanisms to solve the problem.
