I ORGANIZERS

IV REGISTRATION

The tales must include in the first page the following information:

A brief description about what motivates you to write. This description must be written in English. We will not accept a tales that does not come with this information.

V MODALITY

- It is an individual work.
- Maximum three tales per student.
- The length of the tale is between 2 and 4 pages.
- The stories must be configured for letter size paper, written in Arial 12, double space (2.0)
- The theme of each story is free.
- Only stories that meet these requirements, otherwise will be received, shall be considered invalid.
- The margin of the story should be "Normal", ie: top margin 2.5cm, 2.5cm Bottom, Left and Right 3cm 3cm.
- It is very important that all participants comply with these requirements.

VI EVALUATION CRITERIA

At the time that the jury make the decision, take into account the following aspects:

- Drafting consistent.
- Themed Originality
- Innovative narrative structure.
- Ability to create possible worlds.
- Creativity literary text.

VII JURY

The honorable judges of 9th Interscholastic Short Stories in English, will consist of prominent national writers, literary critics and teachers of this University.

VIII PRIZE

It will be awarded to authors of the top 3 stories of 9th Interscholastic Stories in English.

The 3 awards of the 9th Interscholastic Stories in English in each of the venues are available at the following structure:

Prize for the “Best Story”: The author of the best english story will receive an electronic book and one trophy of this competition.

Prize for the “Best Teacher”: The teacher helping the author of the “Best Story”, will get a gift card equivalent to \$30.000.- from Librería Antártica.

Special Award: the 2 top stories obtaining the best evaluation below the first one, will get a subwoofer speaker each one.

IX PUBLISHING

A book containing the best 15 stories from this contest will be published. During the award ceremony some free copies of this book will be given to each author.

X AWARDS CEREMONY

The authors of the best 15 stories will be invited to the award ceremony. Parents and teachers will also be invited.

All the authors obtaining a prize will be informed during the awards ceremony and they will receive a copy of the book.

The awards ceremony will be held in Santiago, Campus Casona de Las Condes, Fernandez Concha 700, Las Condes, November 13 at 12:00 hours.

We remind the participating students presented with the uniform of his property the day of the awards ceremony.

Transportation will not be provided by the university.

XI GENERAL RULES

The works will not be given back to the students.

The organizing committee will be in charge to solve about unexpected situations in the present regulations. And also, this committee is allowed to arbitrate the measurements and use the necessary tools according to the nature and/or topic of the conflict. They will apply the adequate mechanisms to solve the problem.
